Collection and use of Cookies on the Dogs for Good website

1. What are Cookies?

A cookie is a small file which is sent from our website to your computer (or mobile or tablet) to help us recognise it quickly. Cookies allow websites to respond to you as an individual. The website can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences. Cookies also help to analyse website traffic.

2. Why do we use Cookies?

Dogs for Good use Cookies across our website in order to enhance the user experience and ensure that we are able to provide the relevant content that our visitors might expect. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

3. What information do we collect?

For each visitor to our Web pages, our Web server automatically records the page requests when users visit our website. These 'Server Logs' typically include your web request, internet







protocol (IP) address, browser type, browser language, date and time of your request and one or more cookies.

The Cookies we store are necessary to use third party applications on our site such as Google Analytics. The information we gather from these applications does not identify specific individuals and is used by us for statistical purposes only.
